## Solihull Children's Speech Screener

Our **Speech Screener** can help you find out whether your child is using the right sounds for their age. Read through these instructions before you start.

#### **Setting up:**

- Find a guiet space and turn off the TV or radio.
- You can print out the sheets to write on or have them up on a screen with some paper and a pen to make notes.

### Performing the speech screen:

- Each picture shows a word that begins or ends with a particular sound, for example **p** at the beginning of "**pa**int" / **p** at the end of "map". Only try to listen for the speech sound in the section not the other sounds in the word.
- · Complete all the sections.
- Record exactly what sound the child says, if child produces sound correctly put a tick ✓in the section, if they have used another sound write that down e.g. child says "baint" for "paint" write 'b' in the section.

#### Who can understand the child when they talk (use everyday language):

 We also need to know who can understand the child when they talk in phrases and sentences; family, friends, unfamiliar listeners (someone that does not know the child that well). Please make sure to fill out this section of the speech screen if you are referring your child.
