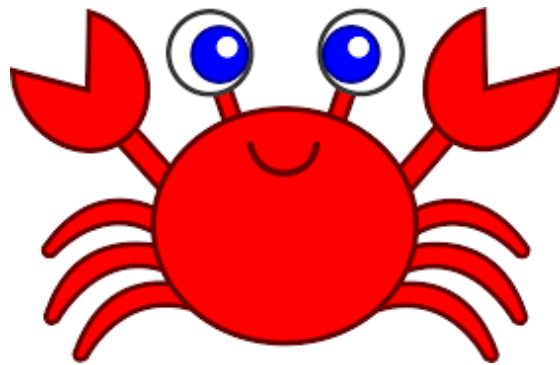

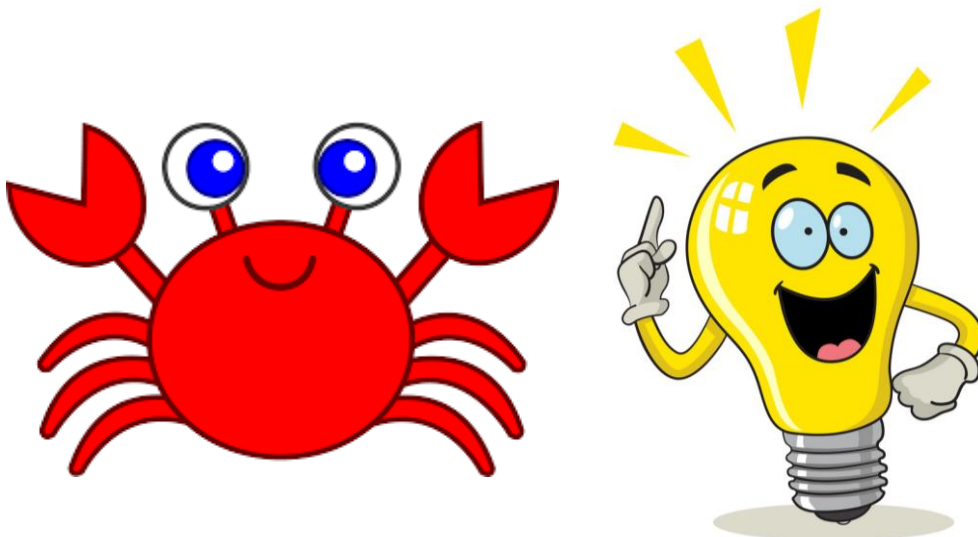

The **crab** has a busy day.

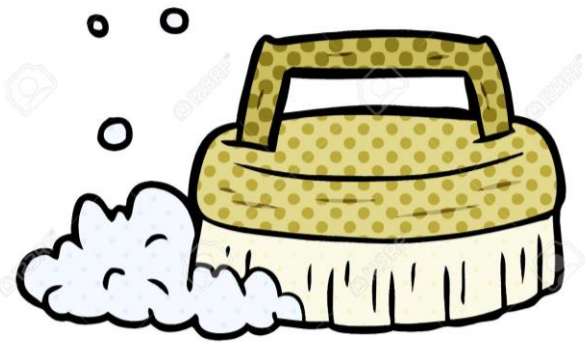
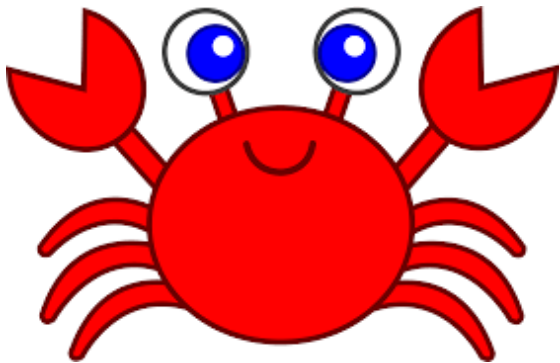
The **crab** was looking forward to a busy day. He was going to go to the shops but he had some jobs to do first. He got up early and had some breakfast.



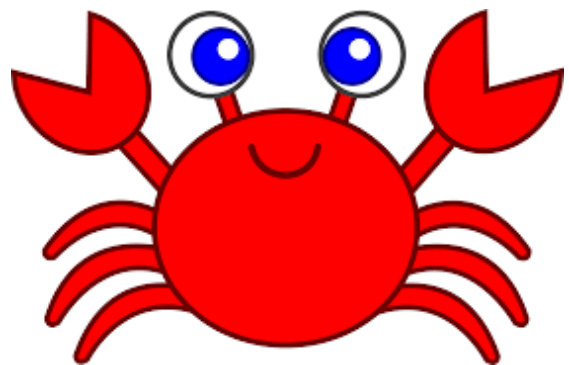
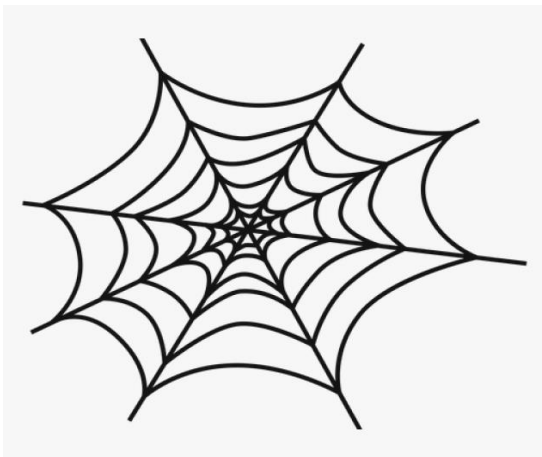
Then, the **crab** started his jobs. His first job was to change the light **bulb** in his kitchen. Once he had changed the light **bulb**, he moved on to his next job.

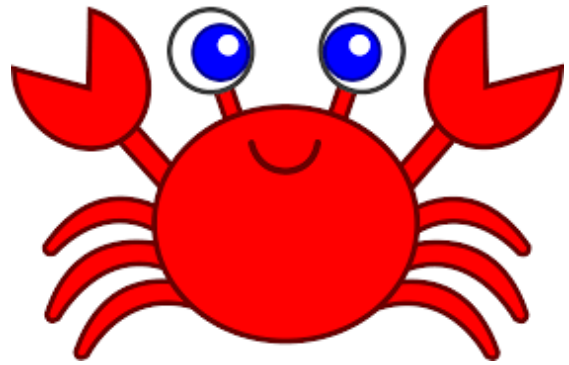
