

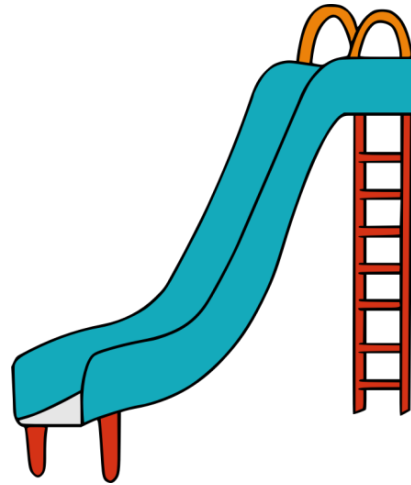

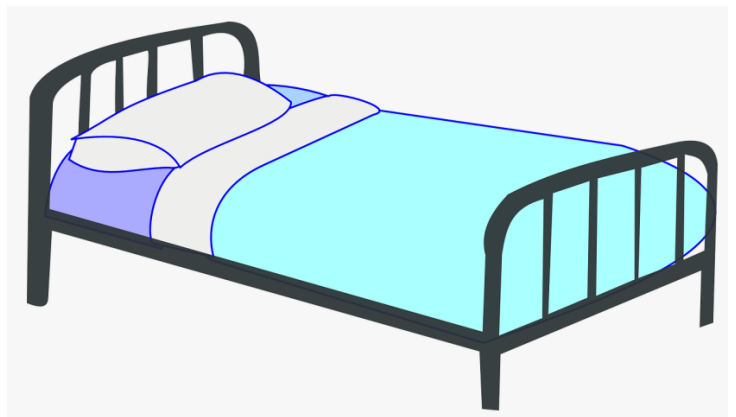

The **bird** goes to the park.

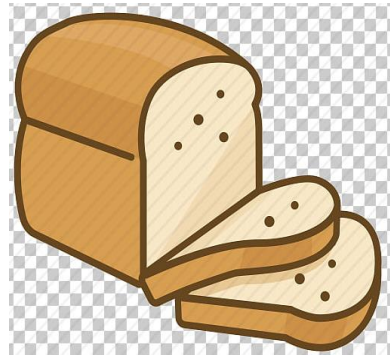
The **bird** woke up really early because he was so excited about going to the park for the day. "I can't wait to go on the **slide**," he thought to himself.

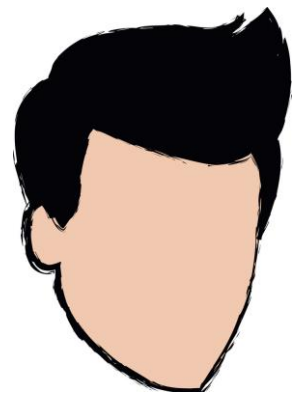
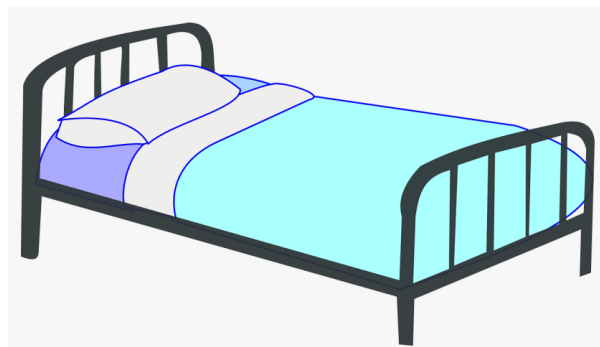
