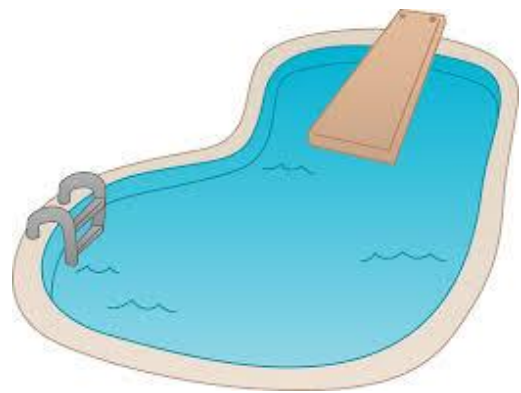


The whale at the school.

The whale at the school.

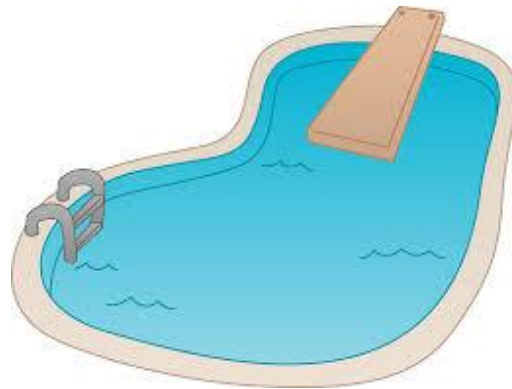
It was a very busy day at the school. The children at this school were very lucky because their school had its own swimming pool.



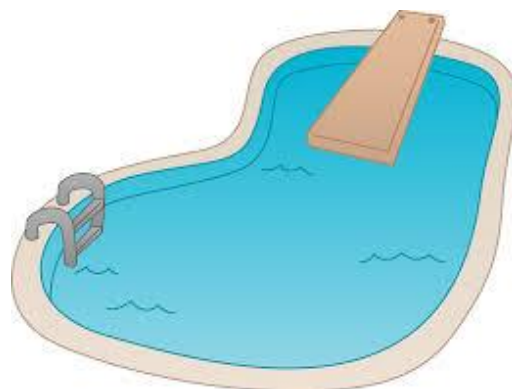
The school bell went and it was time for school to start.



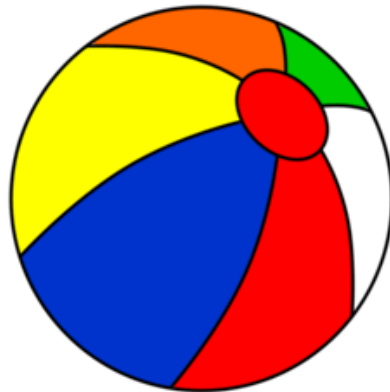

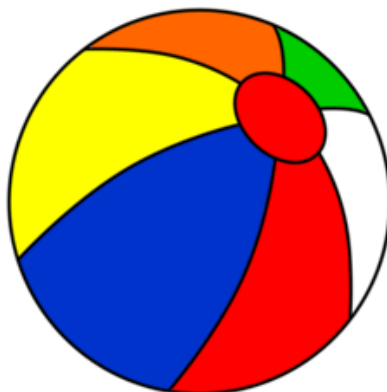
Next, it was the snail's turn to have his swimming lesson in the pool. The snail tried very hard with his swimming. He really enjoyed himself too.



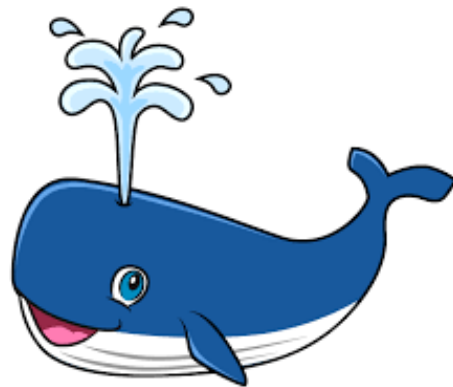
Then, the **owl** and the **snail** played a ball game in the swimming **pool**. They pushed the **ball** between each other and had a great time playing.

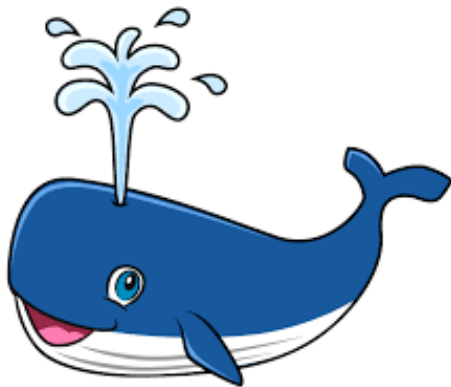

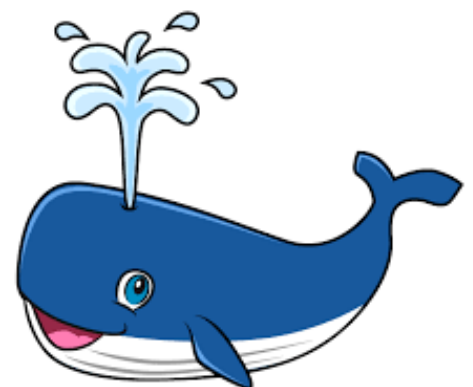
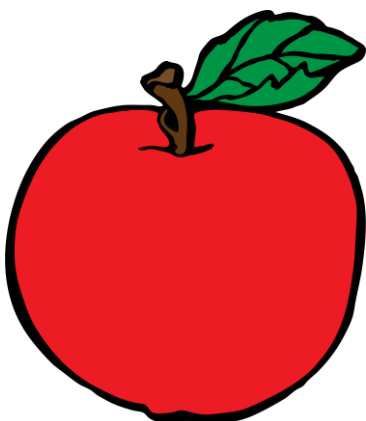
One of the ladies hurt her **ankle** because she was running so fast, she slipped on the swimming **pool** tiles.



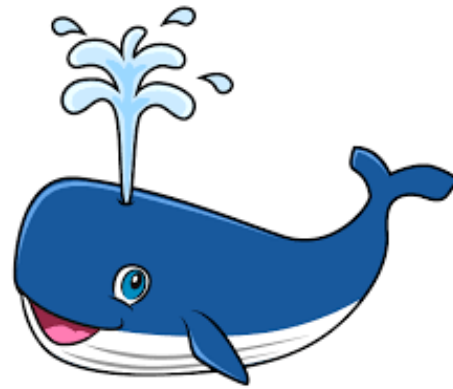
“Hello! My name is Walter,” said the **whale**. “I’m a little bit lost!”

“Don’t worry, I’m not scary at all. I’m a very friendly **whale**!” said the **whale**.



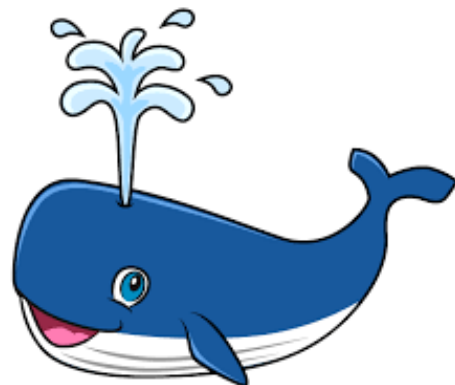
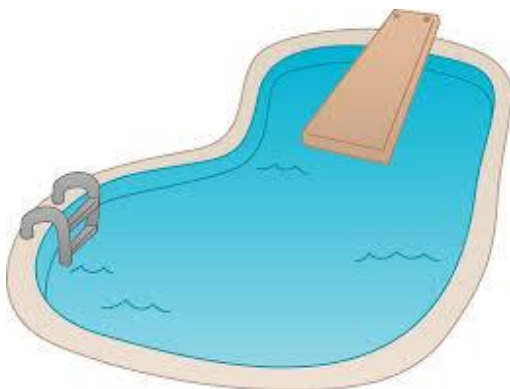
