

## Time for a run.



## Time for a run.


The children got up early and got ready for their run. They went on a run every day as they wanted to keep healthy. "I can't wait to go on our run today," said the boy.

The children started running. They had been running for a while but then, the boy fell over a bone. "Ouch! Why is there a bone in the middle of the road?" he said.




"I've hurt my chin!" said the boy. The girl had a look but there weren't any marks on his chin so they kept running.



After a few minutes, the girl fell over. "Ouch! I didn't see that pen in the middle of the road!" she said.




"Now I've hurt my chin too!" she said. She got up and she was fine so they kept running.
