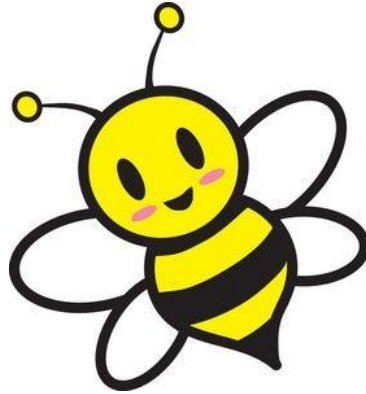


The **bee** and his friends.

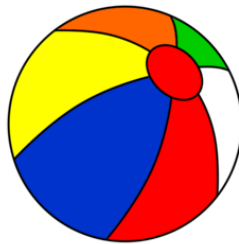
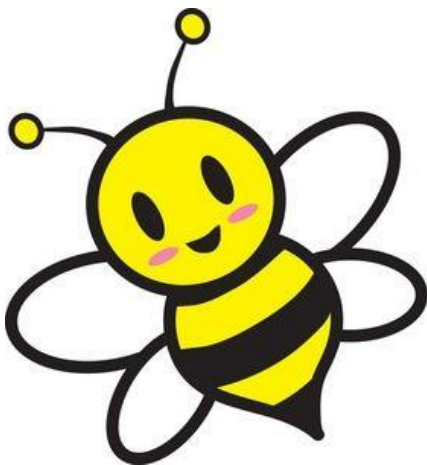

“Hello **Baby**,” said the **bee**. The **baby** was playing with a **ball** so the **bee** joined in.

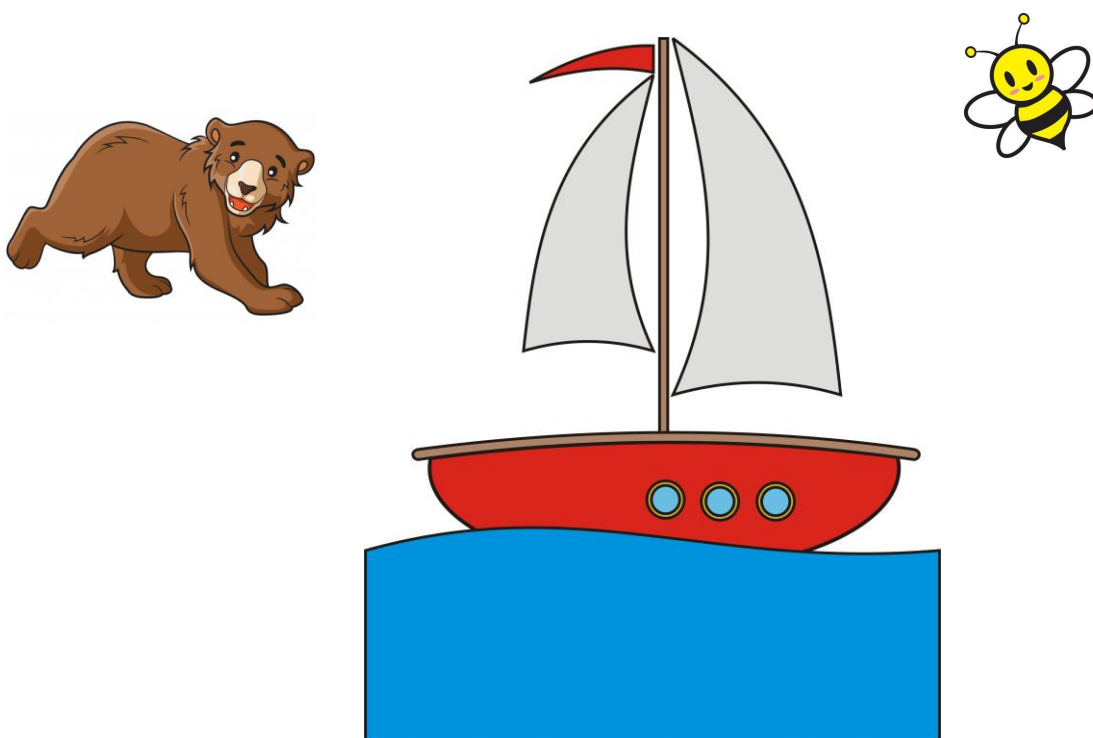


“Bye **Baby**,” said the **bee**.

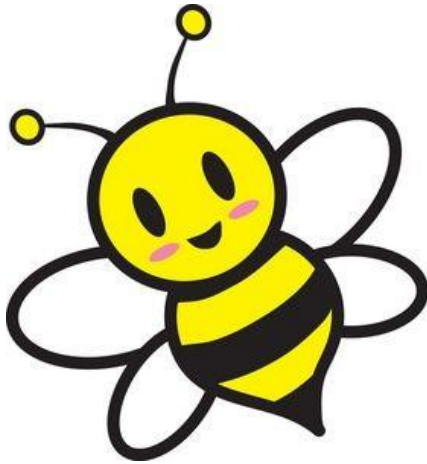
Next, the **bee** bumped into a **bear** who was getting on the **bus**.



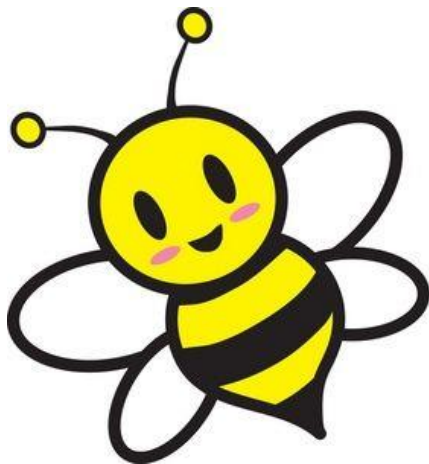
“Where are you going?” said the **bee**.

The **bee** was so tired after the **boat** ride. As soon as he got home, he got into **bed** and read his **book**.



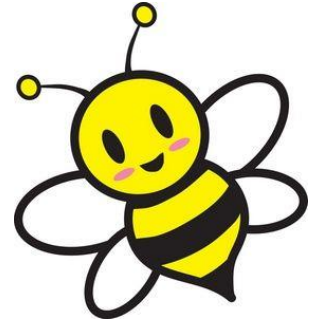
Just as the **bee** was falling to sleep, there was a knock at his door. It was a **bird**.



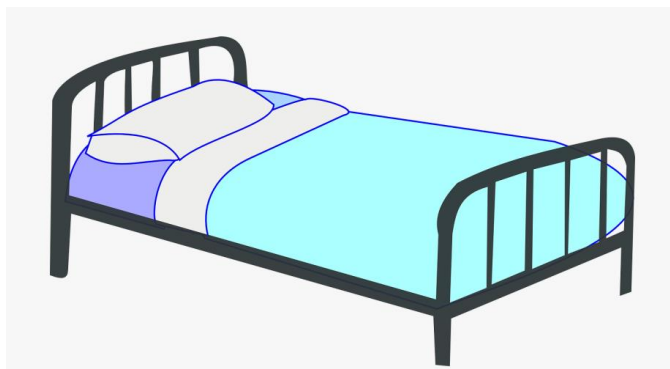
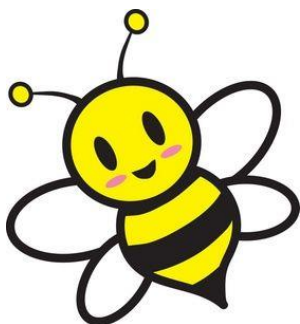
“Hello **Bee**,” said the **bird**. “Hello **Bird**, how can I help?” said the **bee**.
