Chase and the chick.

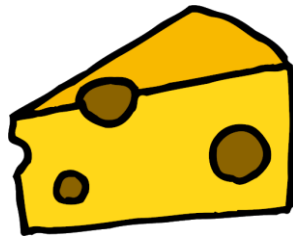
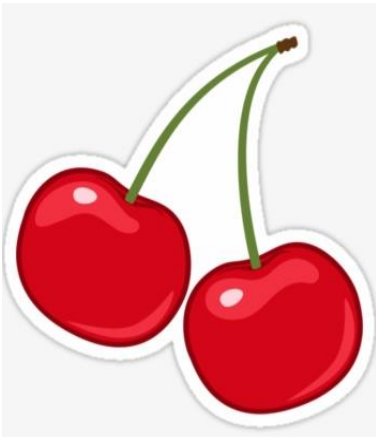
Chase got up early because he was so excited about going to see all of his friends.



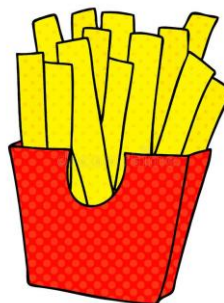

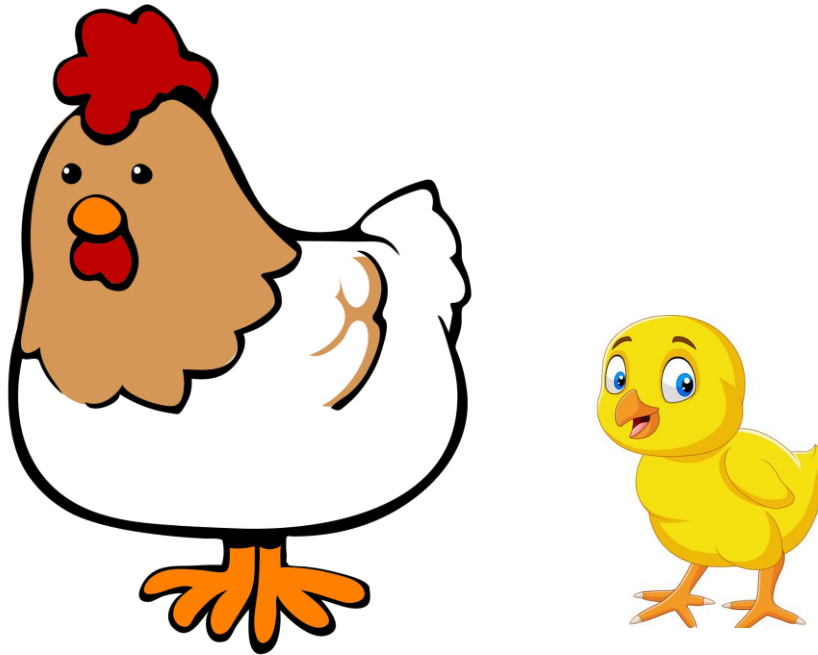
All of the walking made Chase hungry again so Chase got some chocolate out of his pocket and shared it with the chick and the children.
