



The fireman's busy day.

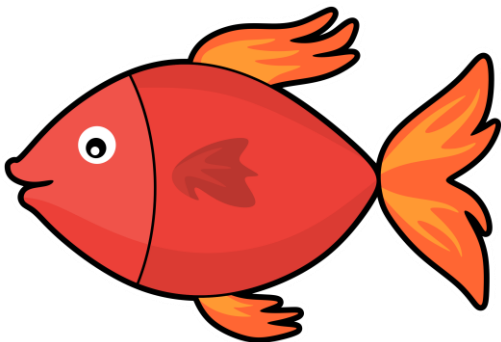
