The flamingo goes floating.

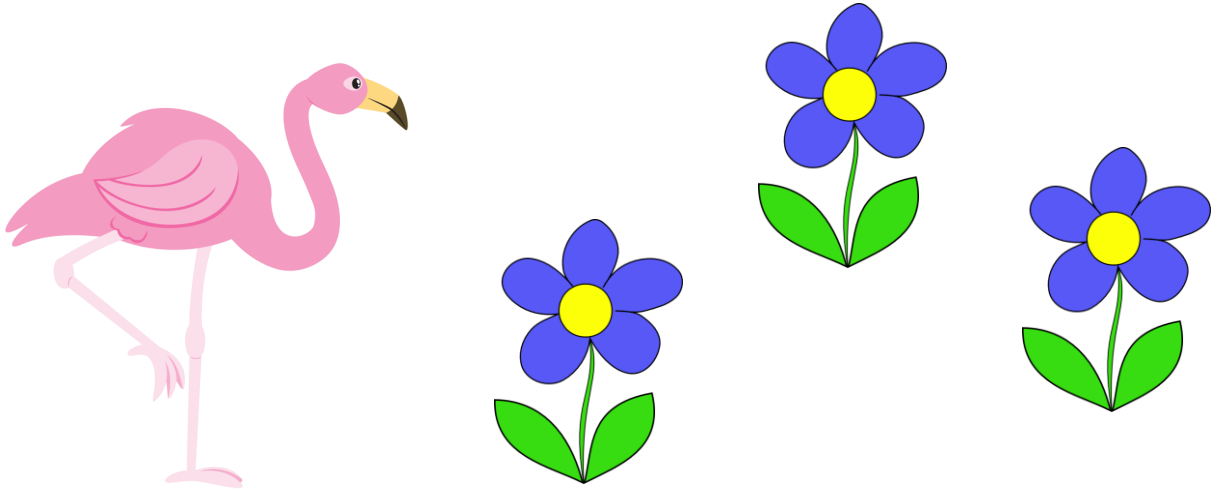
The flamingo was very worried about the flood that was happening in his town. He needed to go out to get some shopping so he got on his float and floated down the road.



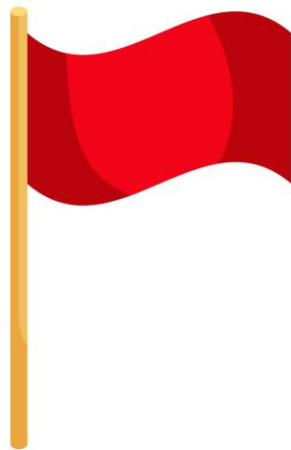
On the way to the shops, he floated past lots of things. First, he floated past a flea. "I need to float past that flea quite quickly," he thought, so he paddled a bit faster.
