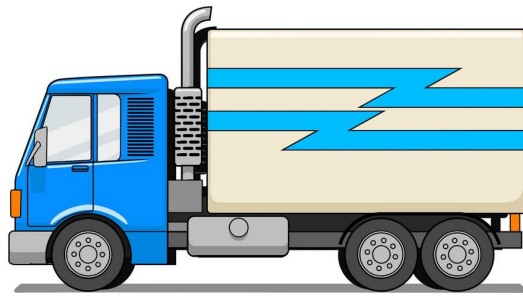


The lorry driver's busy day.

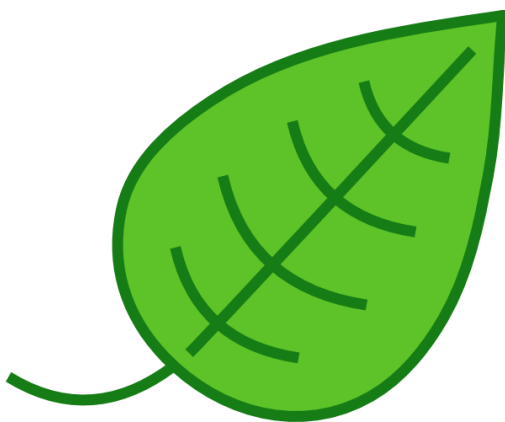

The lorry driver's busy day.

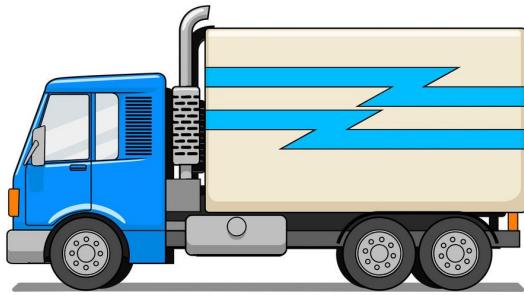
It was going to be a busy day for the lorry driver. He had lots of deliveries to make.



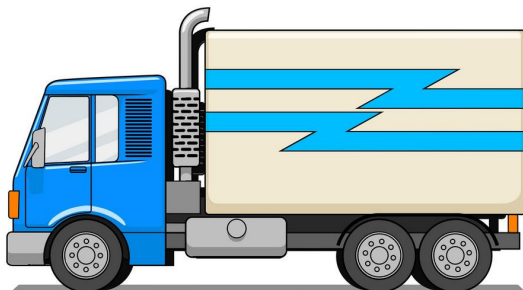
It was a very stormy day, the leaves were blowing around and the lorry driver could see lightening. The lorry driver hoped that he wouldn't have too many deliveries to do that day.



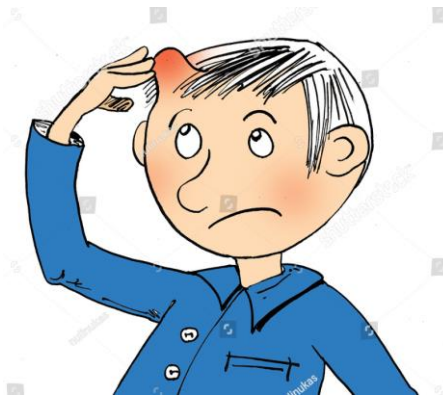
First, the **lorry** driver delivered a **lemon** to someone who was going to make lemonade.



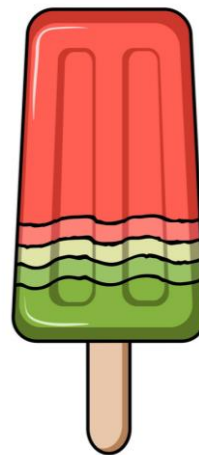
Next, the **lorry** driver delivered a **ladder**.
“I’ve been waiting for this **ladder** for a long time!” said a lady. “Sorry it’s so late,” said the **lorry** driver.



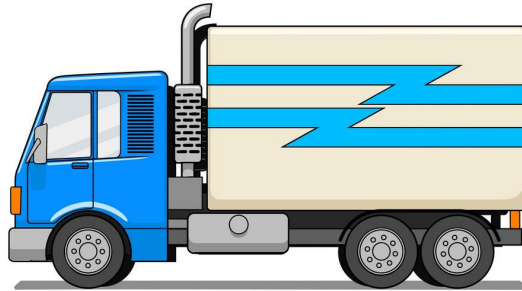
