## The pirate and the party.

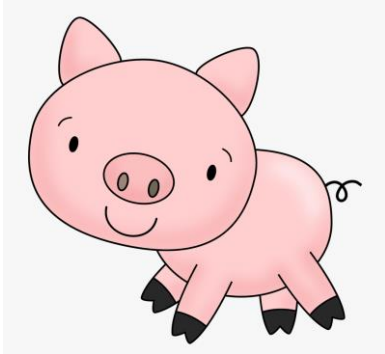
The **pirate** woke up early because he was so excited about going to his friend's **party** that night. He couldn't wait to go to **Panda's party**.



The **pirate** had lots of jobs to do before he went to the **party**. First, he went to the **park** to see his friends.



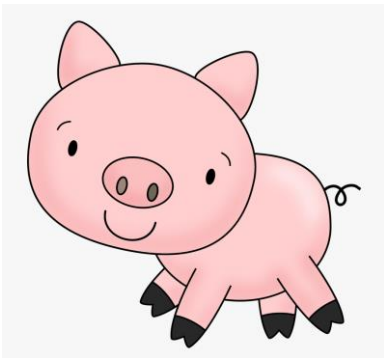
At the park, the **pirate** saw his friends, **Pig** and **Penguin**. They had a wonderful time at the **park**.



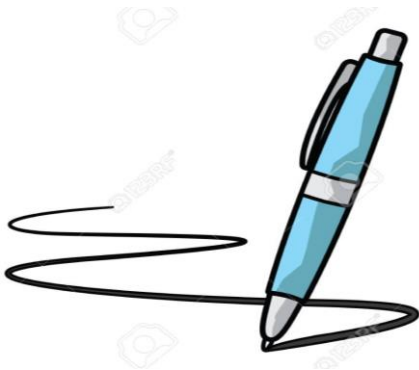

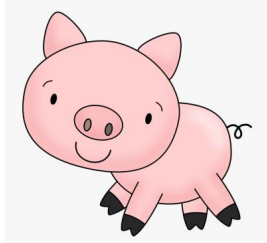
