



The princess and the long walk.

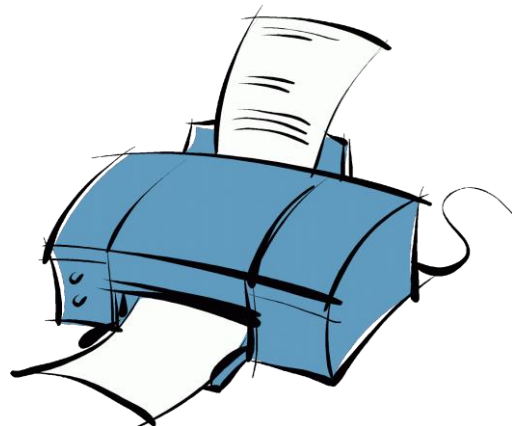
