

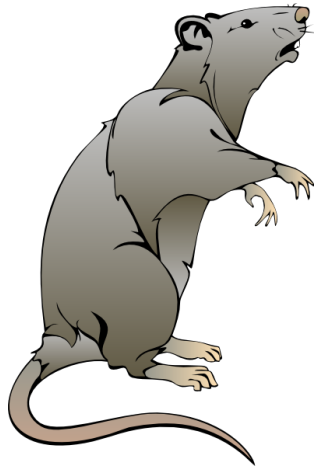


The **rat** buys a **ring**.

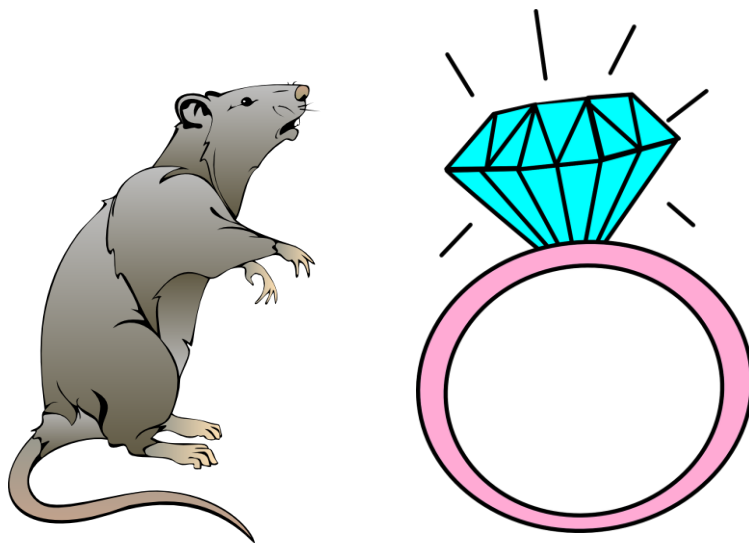
This story includes lots of words that

The **rat** was looking forward to his busy day. He had lots of jobs to do that day.



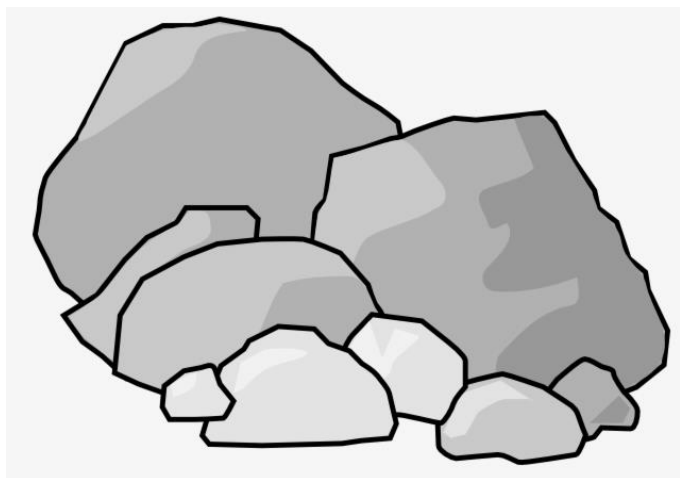
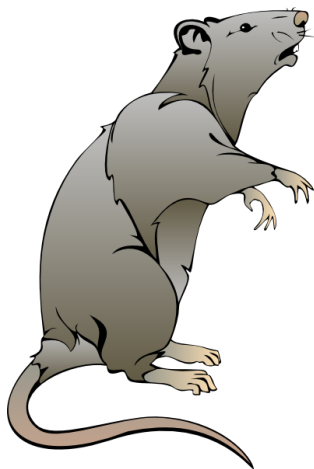

Next, the **rat** walked down the **road** and saw some children **running** by. They waved to him as they **ran** past.



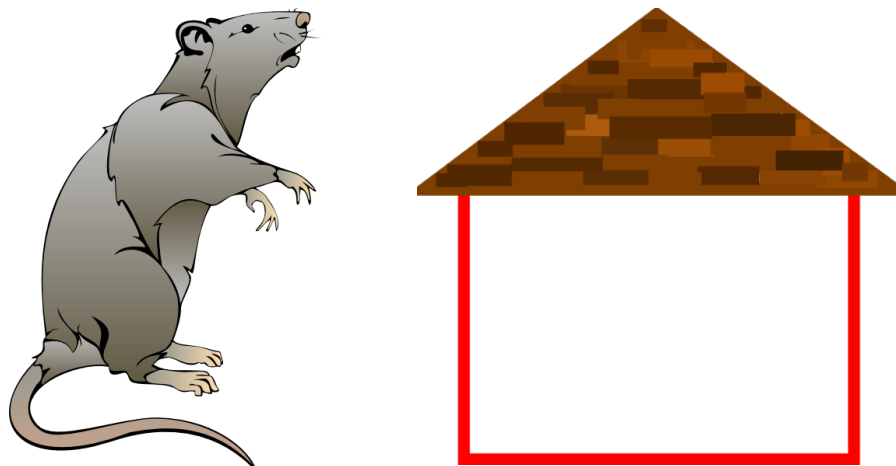
The **rat** was tired from his long walk so he had a sleep on some **rocks**. He only had a short sleep as he still had lots of jobs to do.



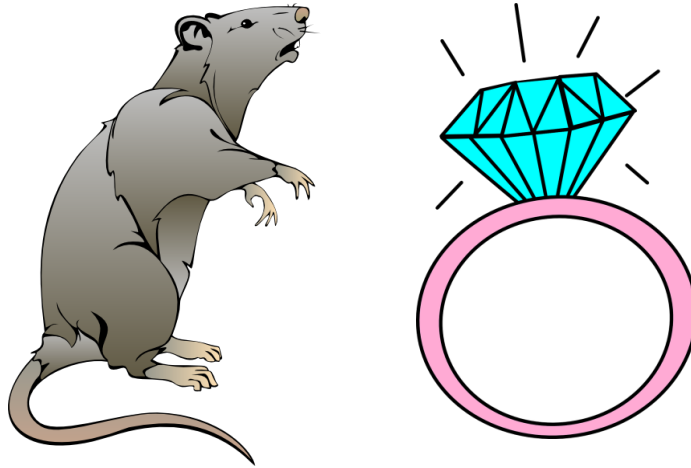
After his sleep, the **rat** kept walking down the **road** but it started to **rain**. “Oh no!” thought the **rat** and he hid under a **rug**.
