As soon as the **sheep** got to work, there were already lots of people queuing up outside her **shop**.



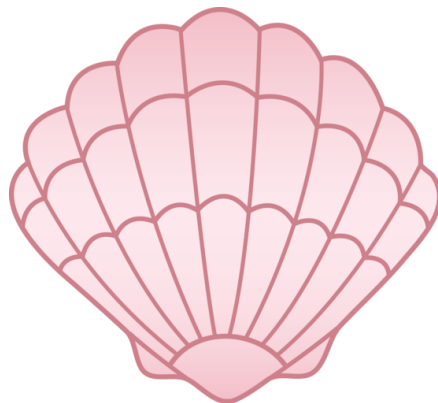

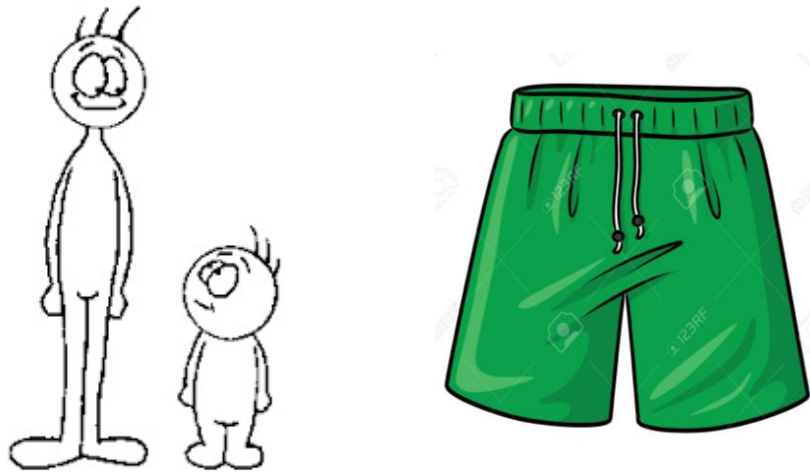
“I think that these **shoes** would look good on the end of my fins,” said the **shark**. “That’s fine,” said the **sheep**.



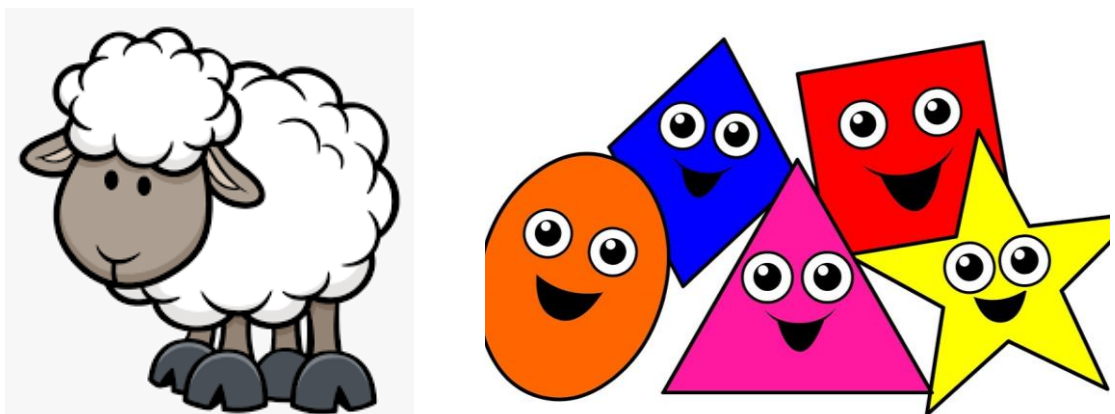
