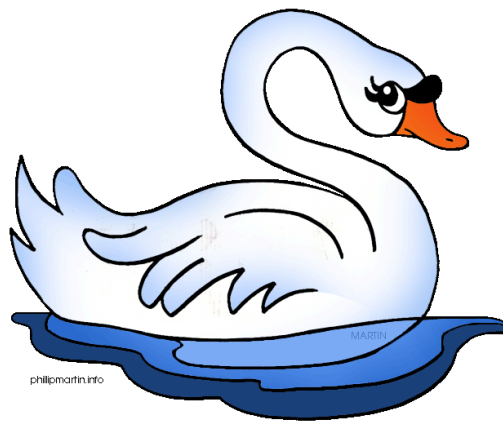


# The **swan** and the **sweets.**

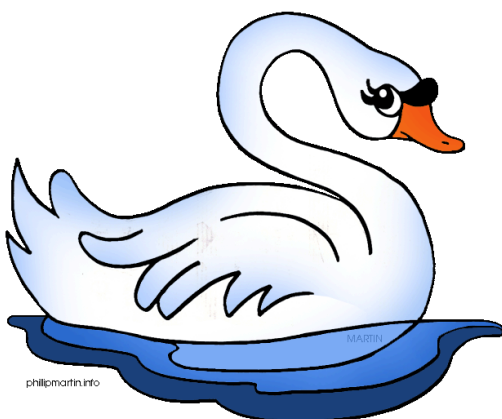
This story includes lots of words that

## The [swan](#) and the [sweets](#).

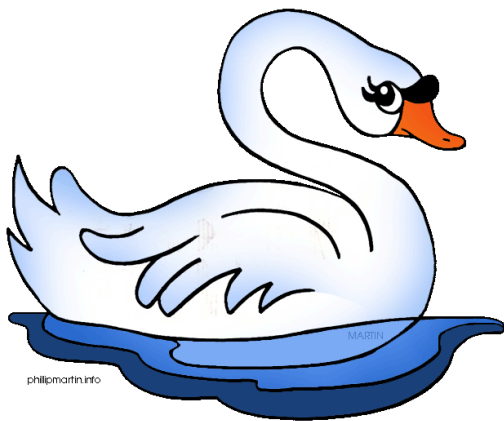

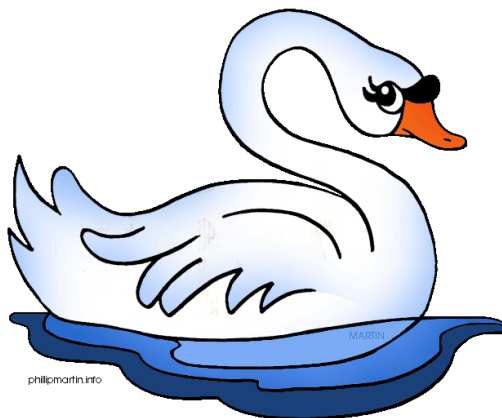
Sam **swallowed** the water very quickly as he was so thirsty.



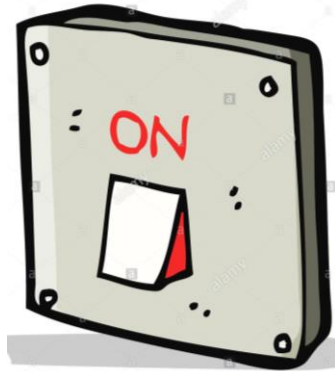

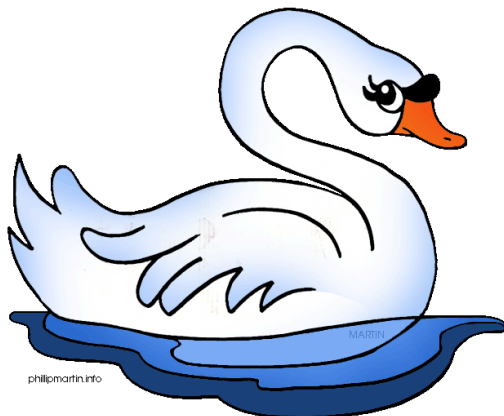
“Please can I have some?” asked the **swan**. “Of course!” said the **swarm** of bees.
