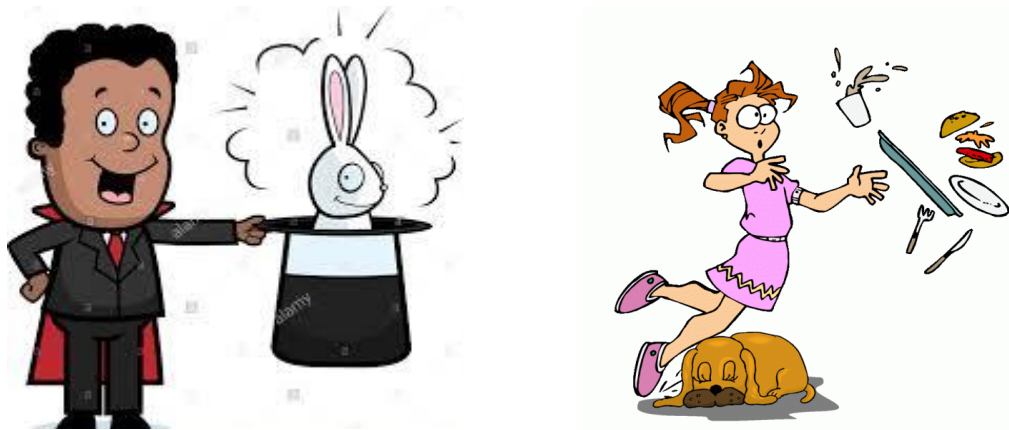
When he got home, he ate a whole **tray** of food then he spent some time practicing his **tricks**.



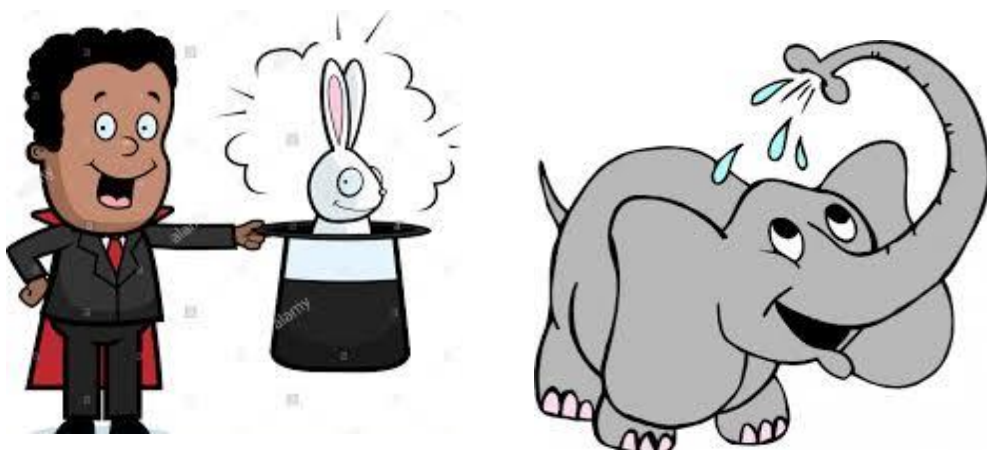

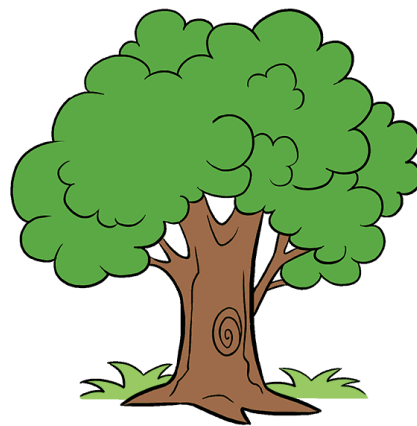
As soon as the magician walked on to the stage, he **tripped** over. “Oh no, that’s not a very good start!” he thought and he carried on with the show.

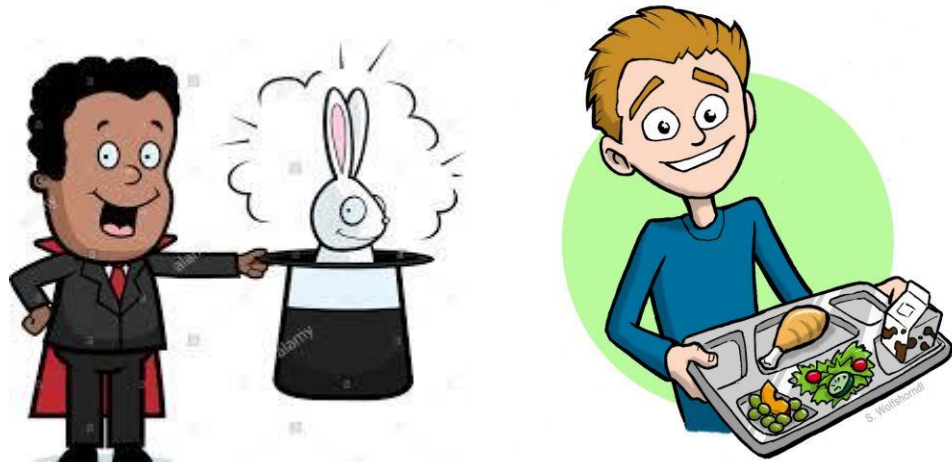
