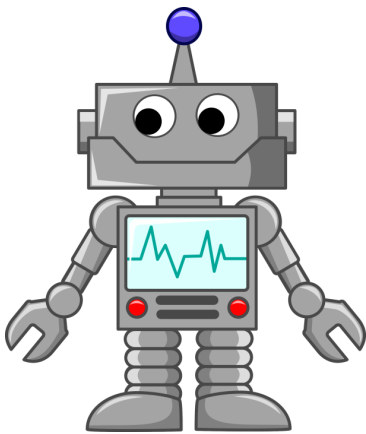


The robot

go to the zoo.

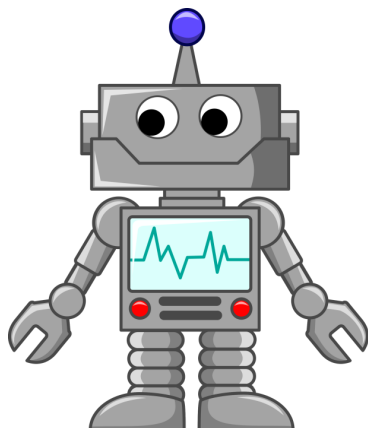

The **robot** and **Barbie** go to the zoo.

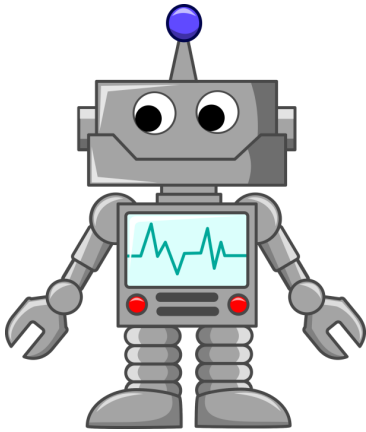

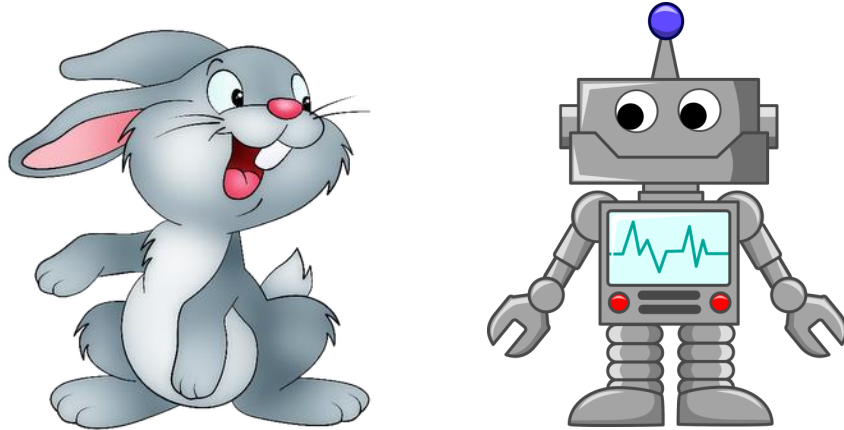
It was quite a long way to the zoo so the **robot** and **Barbie** got on to the **robot's skateboard** and they skated there.



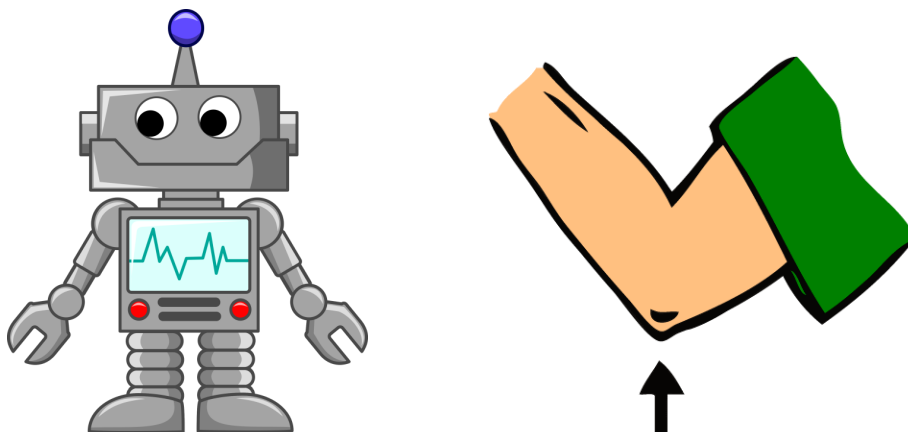

The next animal that they saw was a **rabbit**. “Wow! He can hop so high!” said the **robot**.



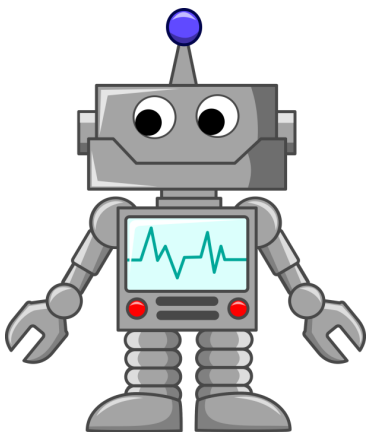
Then, the **robot** fell over and hurt his **elbow**. “Ouch!” he said. The **robot** got up, rubbed his **elbow** and felt better.



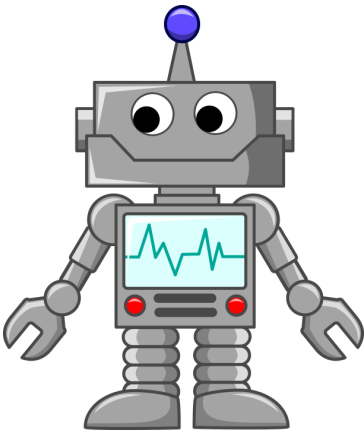

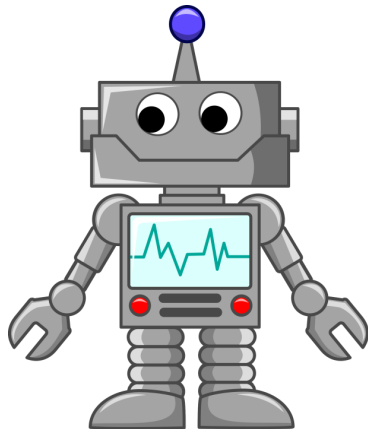
