


The teacher finds a witch's hat.


This story includes words that have /ch/ in the middle.

"I'm so pleased that I could help," said the teacher then she waved goodbye to the witches and started on her way home.






When the teacher got home, it was tea time so she made a burger in her kitchen and put some ketchup on it. "Yummy!" she said to herself.


