witch's hat.

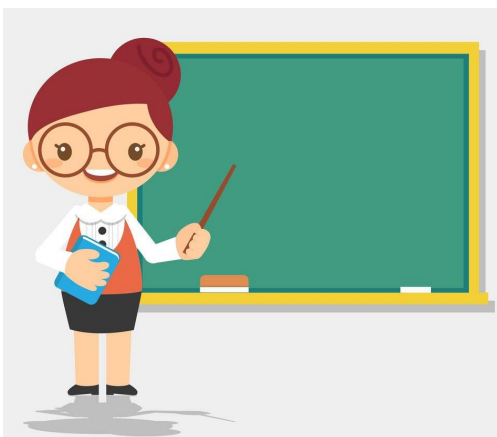

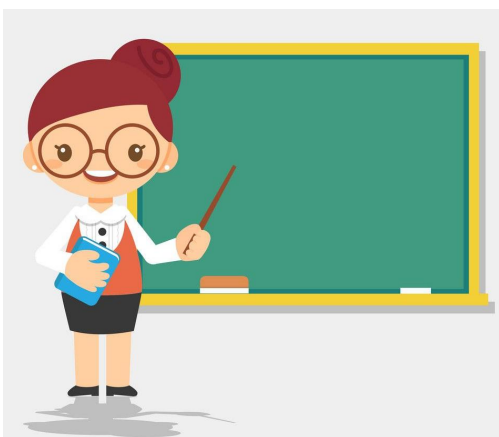
"I wonder who it belongs to. I don't think there are any witches who live around here," said the teacher. After work, the teacher went to try and find who the hat belonged to.

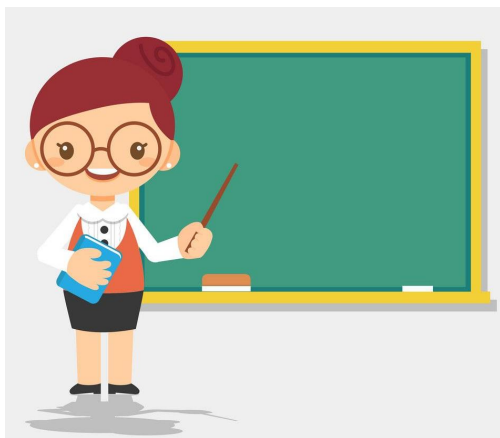

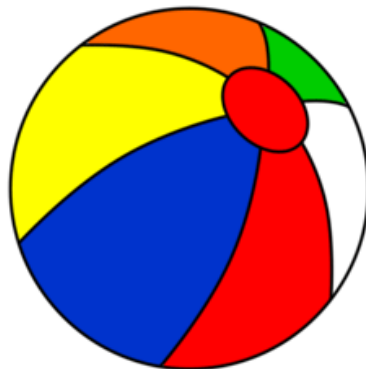
“I’m so pleased that I could help,” said the **teacher** then she waved goodbye to the **witches** and started on her way home.
