



The spider and the windy day.

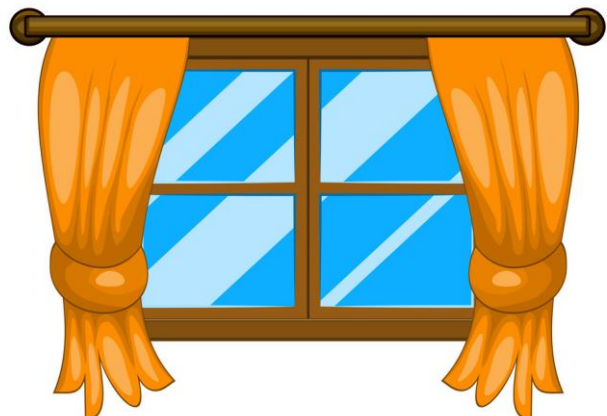

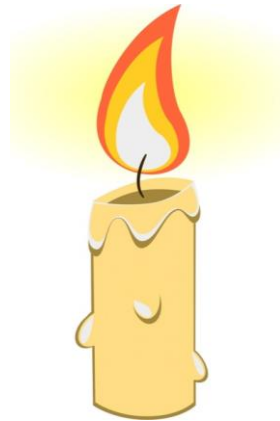

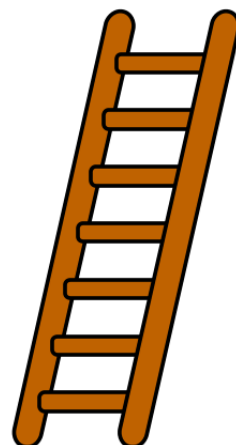
When the **spider** was at the party, he wished the dog a happy **birthday** and danced the night away with the dog, the **panda** and the **teddy bear**.
