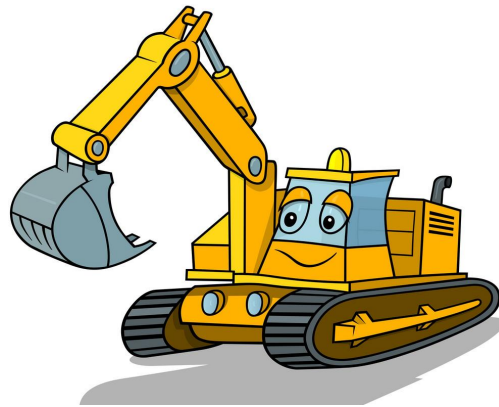
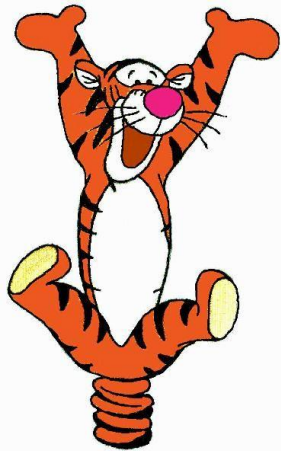


Tigger and the digger.

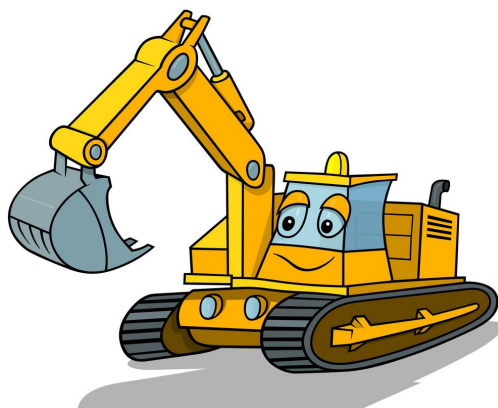
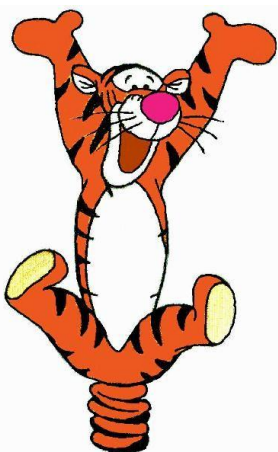

Tigger and the digger.

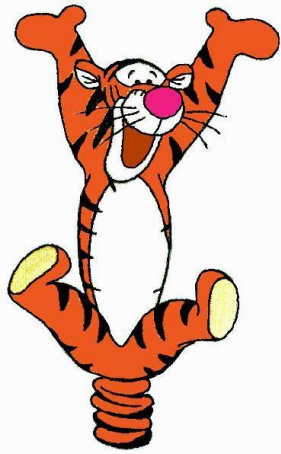

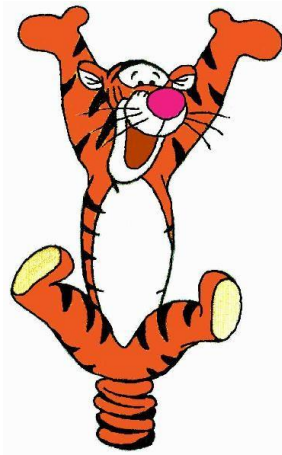
“I won’t be much longer. I just need to do a little bit more **digging**,” said **Tigger**. “That **tiger** is so grumpy,” thought **Tigger**.
