## The family's party.

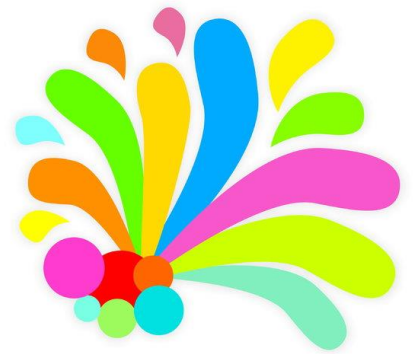
