

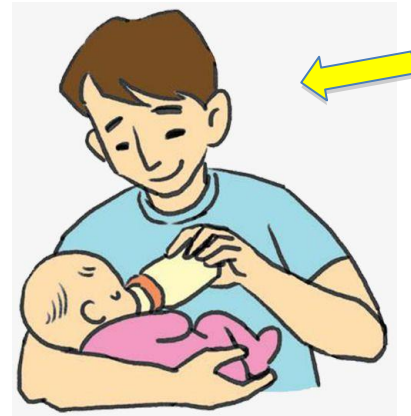


The new mother's walk.

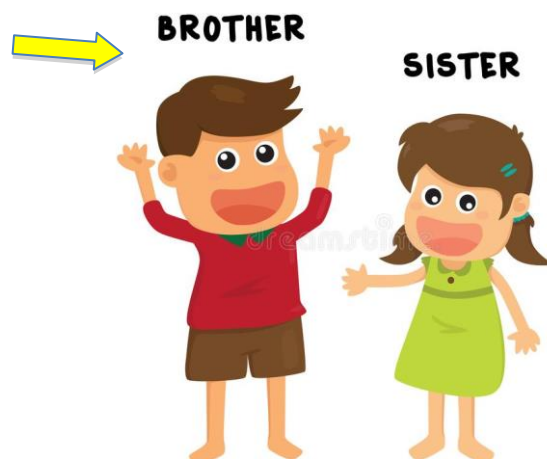

The new **mother's** walk.

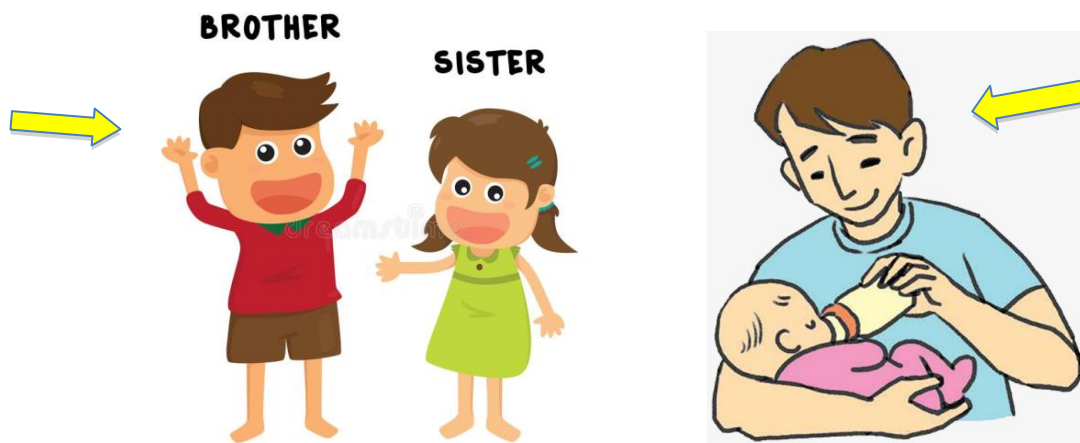
The family had just had a new baby. As soon as the **mother** and **father** got back from the hospital, the children couldn't wait to meet the new baby.
